ART CENTER GUIDELINES

You must be a member of the Artists Guild to exhibit and sell in the VAC (Visual Arts Center).

The application to exhibit and sell in the VAC is a three step process:

1. Complete the attached application and submit 3-5 photos of your current work. You may email digital pictures to rcvartg@gmail.com. Reference your application and size of the work in your email. DO NOT bring in your work until the application process is complete and accepted.
2. The application is juried by the VAC Student Committee at which time you may be asked to bring in samples of your work for review.
3. Once application is approved you will be contacted for an appointment to bring in your work and sign a contract with VAC for exhibiting and selling your work.

The VAC Student Committee meets at least once a month to review applications and welcome new artists. You will receive a confirmation once your application is received with the date of the next review.
