Maximum Number of Art Pieces: Each artist may enter a total of four pieces. Artwork may be 2D or 3D or a combination and must be indicated on the application. Artists entering 2D art exceeding 36" x 48" must supply their own easel or stand and must make a notation on the application.

Display Requirements: Framed artwork must be wired with D-rings. Saw tooth hangers, clip frames or screw eyes will not be accepted. Canvases without a frame must be gallery wrapped. Add size to 2D art on the application. Artwork deemed inappropriate for this venue by the Art Show Chair or committee will NOT be displayed.
